• Keep containers of gasoline no longer than 30 days. Both premium and regular gas degrade rather quickly, hurting engine performance and clogging up gas lines, filters and carburetor channels.

- **TIP:** If you're going to keep gas in a container for more than 30 days, add a fuel-stabilizer product like Sta-Bil, available in most auto parts stores.
- **Before you stow** four-cycle equipment for the season, fill the tank with fuel and stabilizer, and run the equipment for 10 minutes.
- Use low-octane gas. Putting in premium gas won't make the equipment run more smoothly or powerfully. However, just like your car, be sure to run a tank of top-tier gas at least once each season to help clean any carbon deposits building up inside the engines.

Surprising tips on how fueling correctly can save you money

Nick Nicolay of Fenton knows a thing or two about the importance of keeping enough gas in the fuel tank of his 2011 Hyundai Sonata.

"I fill up my car when I'm down to half a tank," said Nicolay, an airplane pilot and assistant manager at Price's Airport in Linden. "In case I have an emergency, I'll be ready to go. I fly planes and don't ever want to run out of gas."

Keeping your gas tank at an optimum level is just one of the things you can do to help save money and protect your vehicle when pumping gas. Since gas is such a major player in most of our budgets, it's important to know "the right way" to pump gas.

There are a few myths and commonly held perceptions out there.

Fill up your tank once it gets down to a quarter full.

"When your tank gets empty, you can burn out your fuel pump," said Joe Yousif of the Marathon gas station on Silver Lake Road in Fenton. "Once your tank hits that marker, you should fill up."

Buy brand name gas.

What distinguishes pricier "top tier" brands is a higher level of detergent additives in both regular and premium gas. These additives help reduce carbon deposits that build up on your

engine's fuel injectors, intake valves and combustion chambers.

When your tank is close to empty, it can burn out your fuel pump. Fill up your tank once it gets down to a quarter tank.

Joe Yousif Marathon gas station owner If you use generic gas, it's a good idea to fill your tank with a brandname gas a few times each year, especially in older cars, according to John Kelly, program manager of the auto technology program at Weber State University

in Utah, quoted in the August issue of Bottom Line Publications.

Joe Yousif, of the Marathon gas station, said that Marathon gas contains STP. "You don't have to add anything else in with your gas, when you buy from Marathon."

Topping off your gas tank not only costs you more, but is also bad for your car and the environment.

According to the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), the additional gas you're forcing into your tank may be drawn into the nozzle's vapor recovery system and rerouted back into the station's storage tanks instead of your car.

If the fuel level in your car gets too high, it can spill into the vapor hoses at the top of the tank and leak into the evaporative emission control system. That could cause your engine to temporarily falter and run poorly, and may trigger your "check engine" light. Because your engine is running poorly, it's also bad for gas emissions.

Use the right gas for your vehicle.

Don't use low-octane fuel regularly in an engine built for premium, or you'll end up with sluggish performance, low fuel economy and may physically damage your engine. Conversely, don't use premium gas unless your vehicle requires it. There is an exception here for older cars (pre-1995), which may benefit from premium gas if they're undergoing severe engine strain, such as towing big loads uphill.

Buy your gas on Tuesday or Wednesday, before gas prices go up for the weekend.

"Those are the most economical days for fueling up," said Yousif.





Where to store your gas:

Experts say you should not leave small amounts of gas in a gas can, or fill the gas can more than 95 percent full.

- Use a tight-fitting cap and store at room temperature, not in the heat or the cold.
- Do not store gas in unapproved, untested containers like milk or soda bottles.
- Do not refill a gas can close to a hot engine, or pour gas into a lawnmower or other small machine when it is still warm from use. Be aware of any possible sources of ignition nearby — flame or spark, including static electricity – when you are using a gas can.

Dear Parents,

On behalf of First Student and Lake Fenton Transportation Department, welcome to a new school year. We take great pride in our department and are looking forward to serving you during the 2014-2015.

Our number one priority is to provide the safest most reliable student transportation service. We focus on the safest loading and unloading procedure for your child.

Michigan State law requires bus stops to be 200 feet apart from one another. Please have your child at his/her bus stop 15 minutes early for the first few days of school. Loading times are approximate until drivers adjust the routes. When routes have been adjusted we recommend your children are at their bus stop 5 minutes prior to their loading time.

The entire bus fleet is equipped with the eight light system, crossing gate, side stop arm, two-way radios, and all buses are equipped with the child check mate system. All the drivers use a uniform crossing pattern, and check their bus after each route to deactivate the child check mate system and hang a EMPTY PLAC-ARD SIGN to ensure no sleeping children are left on board. All drivers prior to employment will have an extensive Local, State and Federal background check on both criminal and drivers license records. After employment we update these records yearly. Physical and substance abuse screening. Random substance abuse screening is performed on the entire transportation staff throughout the year. Post accident screening. Every driver is fully trained with a minimum of 52 hours classroom and behind the wheel training. Every driver is to attend scheduled safety meetings. Every driver is re-evaluated at least once a calendar year.

We ask, for the safety of your child and to continue consistency for the driver that you maintain the same pick up and drop off location every day throughout the week. Your Am pick up may be different from your PM drop off.

- We feel it is very important for you to be visible by the bus driver when unloading your children; this reassures the bus driver and child you are home.
- Please keep your emergency card up to date, any bus changes please notify transportation as well.

Your cooperation and assistance in making sure these policy and quidelines are followed will help insure the personal safety of your student.

Who qualifies for transportation?

Michigan state law does not require a school district to provide transportation to and from school. The Lake Fenton Community School district, as a courtesy to the public, provides transportation to all students who live outside the designated walk area from their home school. The Lake Fenton Community School district has established a one pick-up one drop-off procedure; this means that a student must have the same pick-up point Monday through Friday and the same drop-off point Monday through Friday. The morning pick-up location may be different from the afternoon drop-off point.

School district practice requires that a parent or other designated responsible adult be visible at the bus stop for students at, or under, the kindergarten grade level. If the child must cross the street to board the bus, the responsible adult must escort the child across the road. Kindergartens without adult supervision present at the bus stop will be instructed to remain on the bus and that student will then be transported to Kids Club. Parents of students in grade first through fifth may make a written request that the procedure used for kindergarten students be used for their older children. First Student and the Lake Fenton Community School district will make every attempt to honor each of these requests. It is strongly advised that the parents of young children make arrangements to meet the bus both before and after school, especially during the first week that your child rides to school. This provides a wonderful opportunity to start and finish the school day on a positive note and ensures safety during the walk to and from the bus stop. There are certain programs that require parents or adults to meet the bus. If your student is involved in these programs information concerning special transportation procedures will be made available.

We focus on the safest loading and unloading procedures for your child. Michigan State law requires bus stops to be a minimum of 200 feet apart from one another.

The entire bus fleet is equipped with the eight light system, crossing gate, side stop arm, two-way radios, digital cameras and all buses are equipped with the child check mate system. All the drivers use a uniform crossing pattern, and check their bus after each route to deactivate the child check mate system and hang a EMPTY PLACARD SIGN to ensure no sleeping children are left on board.

- Prior to employment we perform an extensive Local, State and Federal background check on both criminal and drivers license records. after employment we update these records yearly.
- Physical and substance abuse screening. Random substance abuse screening is performed on the entire transportation staff throughout the year. Post accident screening.
- Every driver will be fully trained with a minimum of 52 hours classroom and behind the wheel training.
- Every driver is to attend scheduled safety meetings.
- Every driver is re-evaluated at least once a calendar year.

The policy, for the safety of your child is to have consistent pick up and drop off locations. You must maintain the same pick up and drop off location every day throughout the week. Your AM pick up may be different from your PM drop off.

- We feel it is very important for you to be visible by the bus driver when unloading your children; this reassures the bus driver and child you are home.
- Please keep your emergency card up to date, any bus changes please notify transportation as well
- Please have your kindergarten child wear their bus tag for the first two weeks of school.

Depending upon the instructor, rates per half hour lesson at A Joyful Noise Music Studio vary from \$20 to \$25. "Ninety percent of our students come in for a weekly lesson, but there are other options available," said Bayer.

Adults who want to take piano lessons tend to be in one of three different groups, according to Bayer: some have never played any instrument at all and are truly a beginner, others took lessons as a child and then quit, and some adults play other instruments and would like to learn the piano.

The most common theme she hears from adults who took lessons as a child is, "I wish my parents wouldn't have let me quit."

For those adults out there who would like to learn how to play, there's still plenty of time to learn.

"I can teach an absolute beginner, starting from scratch, how to play for their own enjoyment, or to perform," said Bayer.

End-of-the-year recitals are an option, but not a requirement, said Bayer. "I have had adults who wanted to play in a recital just to get over stage fright. We often play locally at nursing homes



Bayer recommends that budding piano students don't spend a lot of money buying a new piano. "I always encourage people to spend the least amount as possible, until you find that you're ready to commit," she said. "Once you've decided you're ready, there are economical ways to get a hold of a piano. We've got seven used ones here that we use ourselves."

Many people have pianos in their family. "We'll put people in touch with people who have pianos," said Bayer. "Often, it's only for the price of moving it and tuning it."





Downtown Argentine Township winds around the edge of Lobdell Lake. Connected to the south is Bennett Lake, and further southeast is Hoisington Lake.

Marty Vyskocil lives on Lobdell Lake, and is president of the homeowners as-

sociation. Because it's a chain of three lakes, he can take long pontoon rides. He likes the pristine wetlands and wildlife he can see from his pontoon or kayak. "It's just a very fun lake to live on."

"I like the tranquility of the lake, I like the water, I like the views," he said. "It's like being up north, all the time."

The lakes are all-sports, with wake boarding and water skiing.

Vyskocil enjoys the lake with his pontoons, kayaks and stand-up paddle boards. Labor Day weekend brings the Festival of Lights, along with a fireworks display, for which the homeowners raise money through various activities. Because of all the small fingers and bays, there are a lot

of opportunities for exploration.

From watercraft, swans, geese, ducks and other migrating waterfowl can be observed. "I like the swans, the swans keep geese away," he said, adding that the swans are now pretty used to people and their boats and aren't as aggressive as some mute swans.

Between Bennett and Lobdell lakes, there are about 700 properties, he said. Around 20 years ago, he said homeowners purchased water rights, by paying an assessment, which lets them set a steady river level with the dam.

Lobdell Lake has a maximum depth of 78 feet, and covers 545 acres.

Public access is off Seymour Lake Road, between Silver Lake Road and Glenn Hatt Street.

Bennett Lake is 150 acres, and much deeper at 125 feet, maximum depth. This lake is also all-sports, but is on access publicly through Lobdell.

Hoisington Lake is 125 acres, with a maximum depth of 62 feet.

Son camps on floor while visiting dad

DEAR AMY:

My sister is recently divorced. Her ex has moved in with the woman he had an affair with and is living with

her and her three sons. I am concerned about the living arrangements her ex-husband has for my 10-year-old nephew when the boy is with him for his parental visitation. Each of the three boys has his own bedroom. When my nephew stays at the house with his father, he sleeps on the floor in one of the boys' rooms. Any advice or thoughts in getting his father to understand that this situation is not in his

son's best interest? I am concerned that all of this change and turmoil will have a negative impact on this wonderful child. — Loving Aunt

DEAR AUNT:

I agree with you that the boy's sleeping arrangements when he is with his father are very important. Your sister should review her separation agreement — the contract between the two that states the custody arrangement. Sometimes the custodial sleeping arrangement issue is dealt with in this document; the ex-husband may be in violation. She should outline her reasonable concerns to her ex-husband and ask him to provide a bed for their son. She should also call her lawyer to review her options regarding legally forcing this father to do the right thing.

DEAR AMY:

My 7-year-old grandson is about to participate in tackle football. I didn't realize it was tackle until my wife said

> that he would be receiving his pads and helmet next week. When I expressed my intention to inform our daughter of my concerns, my wife adamantly and stridently objected. The reasons she gave were that 1) the family on his father's side is a big football family, and 2) my 'interference' would cause problems in their marriage. I don't know what to do and would take no comfort should an injury occur, knowing I could have

prevented that from happening. What to do? — Granddad

DEAR GRANDDAD:

DICKINSON

I suggest that you ignore the history of football playing in your son-in-law's family and simply say to your daughter, 'Tackle football for 7-year-olds doesn't sound safe. Has the team notified your parents of what steps they are taking to avoid injuries and concussions?' If your daughter sees this as interference, she can let you know. She may also see this as a prompt to look into an issue that is very important. After you have expressed yourself, you need to do the toughest thing, which is to let these parents be parents. Be aware that even the most loving and involved grandparent cannot actually prevent a concussion — on the soccer, football, lacrosse fields — or in gym class. You can only try to mitigate the risk.

At what age can colonoscopy stop?

DEAR DR. ROACH:

I am 75-plus-year-old female in excellent health. My doctor's comment on my most recent annual physical test results was: "Great results on all tests. Excellent report." My question: Is it necessary to have another colonoscopy at my age and with my good health. My mother died of colon/rectal cancer at age 85 in

2002, and all family members were advised to have this procedure. My initial results were two or three polyps removed that were not the type that would recur and were not cancerous. The recommended followup was five years. The results of that exam showed no polyps, slight indication of diverticulosis and no recommendation for

future follow-up. My previous doctor has retired, and I just received a letter from his replacement that I am due for another procedure. I am not inclined to do this at my age, and considering the "all clear" reports of the previous exams and my general good health. I would appreciate your thoughts and recommendation. — B.J.M.



ANSWER:

The odds are low that the colonoscopy would find something there, but there is still a small chance, especially with your mother having had colon cancer. Not having it is reasonable. But since you seem to be otherwise healthy and can expect a longer life than average, I would still say to get it. In fact, I would encourage you to have it.
