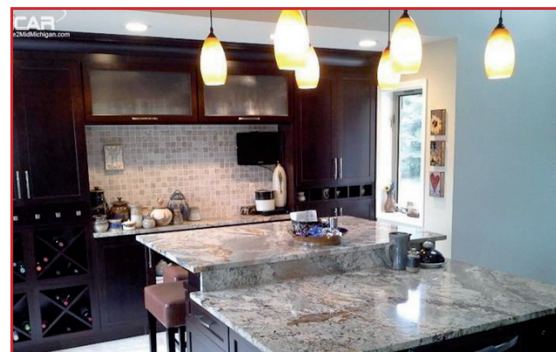

“Opening day is the true excitement of a new beginning which exemplifies the hopes of what is to come,” Linden varsity base ball co ach St eve Bu erkel said. “It exemplifies a built-up energy, like Christmas morning for a 5-year-old child. Not only is baseball truly back, but it gives fans and baseball enthusiasts alive the beginning of a second of excitement when everyone is tied for first place.”

“It’s always fun when the Tigers start playing. You know summer and warm weather are near and it’s one of the rare sports that plays during the day ,” Fenton varsity baseball coach Shawn Lawrence said.

One area coach expects to be at Comerica Park on Friday Holly varsity baseball coach Benny Jackson has been to openers at Tiger Stadium and Comerica Park.

“It’s a great atmosphere,” Jackson said. “Tiger fans are the best. I am all about the game and then all of the partying. I like to be inside to see the first pitch.”

opening day, including one in 1997 at Tiger Stadium when he sat in the center-field bleachers.

“For those who remember Tger Stadium, there was nothing more exciting than the centerfield upper deck bleachers, and to do it on opening day added even more excitement,” Buerkel said. “Also, I can’t forget the home run Larry Herndon hit off the facing of the upper deck well above the 440 sign (in centerfield) in 1987.”

Lake Fenton varsity coach Brad LaRowe will not be able to make it to opening day. He’s never been to one, but that didn’t keep him from creating his own special traditions back in college.

“When I was back in college my friends and I would make it an event. We would tailgate at our dorm or apartment,” LaRowe said. “We’d cook out and watch the games on the television and just enjoy the start of the new season.”

■ Area prep baseball coaches are excited about opening day.

Preseason thoughts about the Tigers have bounced from completely optimistic to almost the complete other extreme. However, if you talk to the area coaches, it seems like the Tigers are in for a solid season.

“I am excited about this year’s team. I really like the lineup they have put together, but that has not been the issue the past few years,” LaRowe said. “I think this team will go as far as their pitching will take them. The starting pitching is solid if they can stay healthy, and the bullpen will make or break them this year.”

“I think they will be back in the playoffs this year,” Jackson said. “(Justin) Upton and (Jordan) Zimmerman will help, but I think the bullpen will be the most important thing to watch this year. If they stay healthy, they will produce.”

Going out to a ball game is a popular activity in the spring and summer, and with the Detroit Tigers opening day on Friday, April 8, many people are planning trips to Comerica Park in downtown Detroit.

Tickets can cost less than \$20, but you're not only paying to watch baseball at the stadium.

## TICKETS

Tickets cost anywhere from \$10 to \$350 per person, depending on the seats you want. The better the seats, the more expensive the tickets.

Baseball fans can buy tickets at Stubhub.com, comericaticketoffice.com, detroit.tigers.mlb.com, and a few other websites.



## PARKING

Parking in one of the many lots at Comerica Park can cost anywhere from \$15 to \$25 per vehicle.

Many people park at a nearby bar or restaurant and then walk to the stadium. The further away you park, the cheaper the parking fees.

Nemo's Bar, which is close to the stadium, offers parking for \$3 and they run shuttles to and from the stadium.

## FOOD

Comerica Park offers a huge variety of ballgame food like hot dogs, burgers, nachos, fries, pizza, tacos, and many other options, including gluten free and vegan items.

Buying food for a family can easily cost more than \$50, especially if everyone has a few drinks and snacks.

However, Comerica Park also allows guests to bring individual portions of food into the park.

## BEER (if you're over 21)

Many people enjoy alcoholic beverages while watching a ball game, and beer at Comerica Park is a pretty good deal. In 2015, a 12-ounce beer cost \$5, which is the average amount people pay for beer at Major League Baseball stadiums, according to Business Insider. Craft beers and full bars are also available.

The park allows guests to bring in a small soft-sided cooler to store beverages in.

## APPAREL

Everyone loves watching the Tigers in the traditional orange and navy fashion to match the team's colors.

However, if you forget to dress accordingly, buying a T-shirt or a hat at the park can cost more than a ticket.

There are seven walk-in stores and eight retail kiosks within the stadium where Tigers shirts and hats regularly cost around \$30, depending on the style.

# Dog enthusiast helping to raise funds for local dog park

Organizers hope to come up with \$25,000 for fencing, benches at Fenton Township park

A YouCaring page has been created to raise money for the Fenton Township dog park that is expected to be done this summer. Kris Johns, who started the page last October after township officials approved the park, said they aim to raise \$25,000 online.

"People love their dogs. When it comes to dogs, people are definitely enthusiastic about supporting it," he said. The page has raised nearly \$200, but the township has received support and money in other ways.

These donations will go to constructing a fence, the parking lot, benches, signage, and other things. They plan to raise funds for other amenities at a future date.

The dog park section will sit on 2 acres of the approximate 35-acre park off Thompson Road just east of Wiggins Road in Fenton Township. There will also be baseball diamonds and soccer fields.

The two-acre dog park will be located next to the wetlands and will be paid for privately through fundraisers.

This is the second dog park Johns has helped with, and they chose a realistic goal for fundraising online. Johns of Grand Blanc and his wife also helped construct the Grand Blanc dog park, which opened in 2014.

"Building the Grand Blanc dog park was trial and error, we've never done something that big before," he said.

Planning and fundraising began in 2010, and they eventually raised \$115,000 for the park. Johns said he has known Fenton Township Clerk Bob

Krug through Krug's daughter, Amy, and they talked about how Fenton Township wanted to start a park system.

"We now know what we need to do to have a dog park in Fenton Township," he said. "We wanted to share that knowledge"

Johns said the park in Grand Blanc is "definitely" a great thing for the community. "We get a great response from residents in the Grand Blanc area," he said.

"We found that people made friendships and they will show up at the same time so their dogs can play together, and they really enjoy going to the park."

He said dog waste has never been an issue because there are waste stations set up at the Grand Blanc park. He's recommended that Fenton Township install them as well.

Genesee County requires dogs to have their rabies vaccination in order to receive a license to enter a dog park.

He said fundraising is going well. A group of people met about two weeks ago to discuss raising money throughout the summer. They will keep the public updated on how much has been raised.

People don't have to give cash donations to help build the park. Spreading the

news will generate more excitement. "They can help build a park by letting their friends and family know that we're building a dog park in Fenton Township," he said.



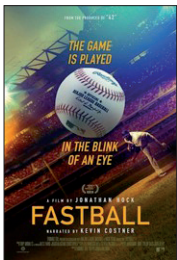

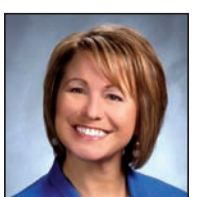
