## Too big for her britches

#### **DEAR AMY:**

I know this is not a life-altering question, but I would appreciate any suggestions you have for me. I have an absolutely beautiful 9-year-

old daughter who is quite tall and mature looking. While she is not overweight, she has a solid build. She has outgrown the children's sizes in the clothing stores, but I can't find anything remotely appropriate for her to wear in the junior's section. (In fact, I am pretty sure I won't find this "junior" clothing appropriate when she is a teenager. What are these designers thinking?)

#### **DEAR MOM:**

My own daughter passed me in height when she was 9, and I well remember the awkward transition and dearth of choices for a girl who is as tall as a teenager but still a little kid. I checked various store sites and also Pinterest for ideas for you, and suggest this basic look to start: Leggings, an oversize T-shirt or blouse and a fun vest and/or denim jacket. ### Too much vitamin D can be toxic

#### **DEAR DR. ROACH:**

I am an 86-year-old woman with three doctors battling over my vitamin D level for many years. I am 59 inches tall and weigh 95 pounds. I

play nine holes of golf three times a week. I have always been a poor eater, so I get little nourishment from food. I drink 3 ounces of scotch every evening with chips. That's my nourishment. I've beaten lung cancer and recently had skin cancer surgery in my ear. The vitamin D situation never goes away, and the doctors keep changing my meds. One of the doctors claims that my

vitamin D count is almost toxic (my blood levels of vitamin D are 121 from my rheumatologist and 145 from my internist), and I have been taken off any meds with vitamin D in them, but it's still high. I am feeling OK now and want to forget the whole matter of the vitamin D level. Your opinion would be appreciated.

#### **ANSWER:**

I admire your spirit for life, even if I don't agree with your diet. I have seen only one case of vitamin D excess in my career. It is very rare if people are taking less than


4,000 IU of vitamin D daily, so I suspect you were taking much higher doses at some point. When I hear that multiple doctors may have been taking care of you, I worry that more than one was prescribing high doses of vitamin D. There also have been cases of manufacturing errors and excess fortification of milk, but these are quite rare. Vitamin D is normally stored in the liver, with the fat cells becoming a second reservoir.

The toxicity of vitamin D is due to high calcium levels, which can cause confusion, nausea and vomiting, and muscle weakness. Toxic levels can be treated with short-term prednisone, but that isn't necessary unless there are symptoms or a dangerously high calcium level. By the time your letter is published, your vitamin D levels should have returned to normal. If they haven't, it's time to look for a rare cause, such as sarcoidosis, where occasionally the abnormal cells can make vitamin D.
