Michigan-grown sweet corn is practically legendary, known for its sweet, tender kernels that are plucked off the cob with each succulent bite.

The perfect accompaniment to an outdoor barbecue, Michigan corn is now in season, and is well worth the wait.

This year's crop didn't come easy for local growers.

"This was the weirdest spring we've ever had," said Dwight Eichelberg, owner of Eichelberg Forms in Fenton Towns

er of Eichelberg Farms in Fenton Township, one of the area's premier growers of yellow and white sweet corn.

Eichelberg Farms finally opened their farm stand on Monday afternoon, July 17, a full week to a week-and-a-half later than usual.

"Our phones have been ringing off the hook with people wondering when

we were going to open," said Marlene Eichelberg, who helps her husband with the farm stand every summer. "It was warm, then really cold, then rained a lot, then there was no rain.'

Corn will be available now through the first frost, "which last year was almost to Halloween," said Marlene.

What brought the Eichelberg's corn crop finally up to date were the blankets he used to cover the corn stalks, keeping the heat in to help grow the corn.

"The wind this spring made this a whole new experience," said Dwight. "I had to watch it all the time, and keep the stalks covered."

After a late spring start, Michigan's warm summer days and cool nights worked together to sweeten the crop, by allowing more sugar accumulation.

Even though sweet corn is the most coveted corn for enjoyment at our picnic table, it's just a tiny kernel of Michigan's annual corn yield.

Michigan farmers only plant about 10,000 acres of the sweet variety. Most of Michigan's corn crop, planted on 2.5 million acres, is field corn — the kind used to feed animals, make into corn syrup, ethanol and even crayons.

Our state is No. 13 when it comes to corn production, while Corn Belt states like Iowa and Illinois top the list. But ask any corn lover here where the best corn is grown and they'll say Michigan

Whether you boil it, grill it in the husk, roast it or microwave it, sweet corn is a very special Michigan tradition.

### HERE'S THE EASIEST WAY TO COOK CORN ON THE COB -IN THE MICROWAVE WITH HUSKS ON

Arrange one to four ears of fresh corn, unshucked, in the microwave. For one or two ears, microwave for 3 minutes. For three to four ears, microwave for 4 minutes. Set the ears on cooling rack or cutting board to cool. When the silks and husks are cool enough to handle, shuck the husks off the cob. The corn will stay quite warm in their husks, so wait to shuck them until just before serving. There are a variety of online sources to show additional ways of cooking corn.




### Waldemar **Wolosiewicz**

# Homemade Salsa

- salt & pepper to taste

- **1.** Preheat your oven to 350 F degrees.
- 2. Place the tomatoes, onions and garlic on a baking sheet and roast for 15 minutes or just until the onions and tomatoes start to get a little char on them. Remove the baking sheet from the oven and let the tomatoes cool for about 5 minutes.
- 3. Add the tomatoes, onions, garlic, green chiles, cilantro, lime juice and salt and pepper to a food processor and pulse a few times until you get the desired consistency.
- Pour in a bowl and cover with plastic wrap (or an airtight container) and refrigerate for 2 to 4 hours before serving.


