South Africa offers culturally diverse food, hiking, busy cities and more

When you think of South Africa, you probably imagine safaris, wild animals, and jungles. The country offers much more than that, with huge cities, multiple mountain ranges, and sealife right off the coast. The county

contains people from many different nationalities and each bring parts of their own culture.

From hiking to exploring densely populated cities, South Africa has much to offer as a travel destination.

Passports and Visas

U.S. citizens with passports visiting the Republic of South Africa for up to 90 days for tourism or business purposes do not need visas.

Health concerns

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends getting the usual vaccines for visiting South Africa, like measles, mumps and polio. They also recommend vaccines against rabies, hepatitis A, tetanus, and typhoid.

Beware of thieves

of the most popular cities in the country, many of the houses have bars on the windows, high-security gates for the driveway, and electric fences. Security guards frequently patrol housing complexes, parking lots, banks, malls and gas stations.

After apartheid ended, violence became a bigger issue in the country. South Africa has some of the worst crime rates in the world. If you're traveling to South Africa, don't flash any expensive items, avoid looking like a complete tourist, and avoid non-tourist areas at night.

Time difference

South Africa is six hours ahead of Fenton.

Distance and airfare

According to Tripadvisor, flights from Flint's Bishop Airport to Cape Town Central in South Africa cost around \$1,900. Flights are about 28 hours long.

Instead of barbeque, South Africans eat braai, which means grilled meat in Afrikaans. Having a braai is similar to having a barbeque. Other traditional foods include minced ostrich and the sweet koeksisters, which is fried dough infused in syrup or honey. While the county has a significant emphasis on meat, vegetarian options can be found almost everywhere.

Other popular foods include boerewors, which is sausage, mixed with pork or lamb, and Cape Malay curry. The spices used in the curry come from Indonesia, India and Malaysia. Most South Africans frequently enjoy chakalaka and pap, which is a vegetable dish made of onions, tomatoes, peppers, carrots, beans and spices.

Politics

South Africa is a Republic. After years of apartheid and dangerous racial tensions, Nelson Mandela was the first democratically elected president in 1994. South Africa doesn't have one legally defined capital city. Instead, there are three capitals: Pretoria (executive capital), Bloemfontein (judicial), and Cape Town (legislative).

MUST-SEE ATTRACTIONS

Cape Town

Cape Town contains attractions like Table Mountain, which is a national park of mountains with forests and marine protected areas like the Cape of Good Hope. Tourists can visit the winelands near Stellenbosch, go see the whales at the Whale Coast along the Overberg, and Cape Agulhas, the southern tip of Africa, where the Atlantic and Indian Ocean meet.

Kruger National Park

This national park lies along the border of Mozambique and Zimbabwe. It covers 20,000 square kilometers with 14 different eco zones, each with different wildlife. People come to Kruger National park to see lions, leopards, elephants, rhinos, buffalo and more. It's recommended to visit this park in the dry season, and stay at a camp like Olifants. It's best to stay in the southern park along the rivers.

Johannesburg

This city is the economic heart of Africa and the most common entry point into Southern Africa. Here, you'll find typical shops and city attractions. Go see a play or live music at the Market Theatre area, visit the planetarium, or see the Mandela Family Museum. Take a cab or an Uber to explore the city and experience the heart of South Africa.

Drakensberg mountains range

"Drakensberg" means "mountains of the dragon" in Dutch. However, you won't see any dragons at this spectacular sight for hiking. In the north, many hikers choose to hike around the amphitheater or on top of it. It's about a two-day hike to the top of the mountain.

In the south, the Sani Pass, also called the "no man's land," can only be traversed by four-wheel drive vehicles.

Tugela Falls

These falls are located in the Royal Natal National Park. It contains the secondhighest waterfall in the world with a total drop of 947 meters, or 3,110 feet, with five leaps. Located on the Gorge Walk, people are only advised to go if they're young, fit, and there hasn't been heavy rainfall. It's recommended to not bring any valuables like cameras or phones.

INGREDIENTS

- 1 "seamless" crescent roll dough
- 1 cup cooked shredded chicken
- 1 cup frozen peas and carrots (no need to thaw)
- 1/2 can cream of chicken soup
- 4 oz cream cheese (softened)
- 1/2 cup shredded cheddar cheese

DIRECTIONS

Preheat oven to 375. In a large bowl, mix chicken, veggies, and shredded cheese.

In a smaller bowl, combine soup and cream cheese. Add this to the veggie mix. Spread crescent roll dough

on parchment paper, and place it on baking sheet. Keeping 3" in the center in tact, make cuts about 1/3 of the way in and down both long sides of the dough. Cuts should be about an inch apart. Spread the mixture down the middle. Take a strip of dough from one side and fold it over the mixture. Do the same with a strip from the other side. Alternate back and forth, giving it a 'braided' appearance. Pinch the ends shut.

Bake 20-25 minutes, getting the top nice and golden brown. NOTE: next time I would throw a few slices of cooked, crumbled bacon in!!
