Fenton has a rich and interesting history. Did you know that the town was built on an old Indian burial ground? In 1998, it was reported that a developer clashed with an archaeologist over the possibility of Native American remains in an area that was to become a new subdivision.

Fenton residents hired an expert to confirm the existence of Indian mounds on the property. According to the expert, the fact the old Fenton has a "Mound Street" should set off a red flag. He said that any remains found would have been given to a Native American tribe to bury.

Did you know that Fenton also is a protected archaeological site? It would seem that ancient people lived all over Fenton.

A bar once served as city hall in Fenton. According to the Fenton Historical Society, community leaders had their meetings at a popular hotel bar, back before they had a city hall.

Fenton was founded in 1818 but the founder didn't file the paper work until 1837. This year the city will be celebrating its 175 Anniversary, but it's really 194.

Upcoming events in Fenton include the "Light up the Valley" After Hours at Delmar Gardens on Nov. 30. The Fenton Area Chamber of Commerce also will host its annual awards holiday dinner on Dec. 7.

The population of Fenton, Missouri was 4,045 (estimated 2014). Fenton, Michigan has a population of 11,367 (estimated 2016).

Pros and cons to keeping pigs as pets

Pot-bellied pigs can be a welcome addition to

a home. With education, training and patience,

pigs can make great pets.

People are drawn to pets for various reasons. Self-sufficient cats entice those who prefer independent pets that do not take up much space. Dog lovers might enjoy the

companionship and boisterous personalities of tail-wagging pooches. Exotic pet owners appreciate the uniqueness of their reptiles and amphibians and how they may serve as a conversation starters.

Pot-bellied pigs also can make for interesting pets that can make for beloved additions to households. Curious, trainable and very intelligent, pigs offer more as pets

than many people may realize. Many people mistakenly perceive pigs as dirty, smelly, sweaty messes. Such misconceptions may make people weary of adopting pet pigs. While not ideal for everyone, pot-bellied pigs can make wonderful pets.

The Pig Placement Network, a service that facilitates pot-bellied pig adoptions and placement, says that while pigs are highly trainable and can learn at a faster rate than dogs, the behavior of pigs is quite different from canines. Prospective pig owners must learn the intricacies of pigs before considering taking one in as a pet.

Pigs are regarded as prey and therefore have developed a suspicious nature. It can take time to earn a pig's trust. Furthermore, pigs can become stubborn, depressed and easily bored

if not given adequate attention. This may lead to destructive or aggressive behavior. Mini Pig Info, another pet pig resource, says pigs will constantly test limits. They quickly can

learn that squealing will get them attention. Unlike other pets, pigs' emotions closely mirror those of humans.

Pot-bellied pigs, which originated in Vietnam, are one of the smallest breeds of pigs as compared to what one would find on a farm. Piglets may start out small and cute, but even a smaller potbellied pig can reach 100 to 170 pounds in adulthood. Those who don't understand this ahead of time contribute to the growing

number of pet pigs surrendered to shelters.

Other factors that can influence if a pig is the right pet for a person:

- Pot-bellied pigs can live an average of 12 to 15 years with proper care.
- Communities have their own specific rules regarding pet pigs. Check if pigs are legal before adopting one.
- Pigs are not apartment dwellers. They will need exercise and access to a yard that allows for rooting and exploration.
- Pigs have a pronounced sense of smell and will immediately know when someone is eating or opening food.
- Finding a veterinarian who is familiar with pot-bellied pigs is key to maintaining the animal's health and longevity.

INGREDIENTS

- 3 leek whites, washed and sliced thin
- 4 stalks celery, chopped
- 3 cloves garlic, minced
- 8 Yukon gold potatoes cubed (I used red, couldn't find Yukon's in the store)
- 8 cups vegetable stock
- Fresh Rosemary, sage & thyme, tied in a herb bundle
- 2 c. cubed butternut squash
- Olive oil
- Salt
- Pepper
- 1/4 1/2 c. Panko bread crumbs (to thicken)

DIRECTIONS

Preheat your oven to 400. Peel & cube butternut squash. Toss it with 1-2 tbsp olive oil, salt & pepper, and minced garlic. Spread the squash out on a sheet pan, and roast 25 minutes. Remove from oven and set aside. Preheat 2 tbsp olive oil in a large dutch oven. Saute' and soften the leeks and celery, until they're translucent. Poor in vegetable stock. Add potatoes and herb bundle. Simmer for about 20 minutes or until the potatoes are soft. Remove the herb bundle. Add in bread crumbs, stir to thicken. Add in the cubed butternut squash, heat through. If you want the soup more smooth, use an immersion blender and puree to the consistency you want. Salt and pepper generously! This is EXCELLENT with a good, crusty bread.
