### CITY OF FENTON

When our own sons were little, we took them camping, usually up north to Higgins Lake.

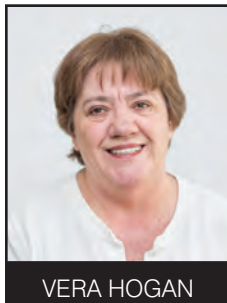
Something very special happens when you camp with your family — new friends happen. Whether it's just for the duration of the camping trip, or for life, adults and children can't help making new friends at the campground.

If you get tired of swimming, there's a disc golf course, a volleyball pit, ball fields and horseshoes for family fun, as well as pavilions for party rental.

The park is easily accessed from the south end of Silver Parkway, or from the north off Jennings Road, just west of Silver Parkway.

A season pass for city residents will cost you \$20, effective from Memorial Day through Labor Day. Non-residents will pay \$30 for the season. Walkers can enter for just \$1 per day, a carload is \$5 and for a bus, \$30.

### FENTON TOWNSHIP

**Clover Beach** on Byram Lake in Fenton Township, near Linden, is a popular summer destination for families from Memorial Day to Labor Day.

Come and enjoy a wide sandy beach and a scenic picnic area and playgrounds that overlook the beach. Operated by Genesee County Parks, admission is free.

One of Fenton Township's hidden gems is the **Fenton Township Park and Beach** directly behind the Fenton Township Civic Community Center on Mantawauka Drive.

Open from Memorial Day to Labor Day, the sandy beach provides lots of opportunities for swimming in a tied-off area from the rest of Lake Fenton. There are also picnic tables, playground equipment and a winding boardwalk with a barrier-free ramp. There is no charge to enjoy this park and beach.

### HOLLY TOWNSHIP

The **Holly Township Beach** on Bush Lake is open from mid-June through Labor Day, seven days a week.

Lifeguards are on duty during park hours, 12 to 8 p.m. and after Aug. 11, from 12 to 5 p.m. on weekdays and 12 to 8 p.m. on weekends.

In addition to the beach, there's a playscape and swing set, shuffleboard courts, volleyball courts and picnic area with barbecue grills.

A concession stand is open for drinks and snacks and a pavilion is available for rental.

A day pass to the beach is \$2 per person. A season pass for Holly Township residents is \$5 and \$10 for non-residents.

**Seven Lakes State Park and Beach**, between Fenton and Holly off Fish Lake Road, is a favorite destination, not just for swimming, but also for fishing, canoeing and kayaking in its seven lakes.

The beach is a summertime hot spot for swimmers and families who want to enjoy a day in the sun.

You'll find public restrooms and concessions. However, there are no lifeguards on duty. In addition to swimming, you'll find a large picnic area with horseshoes, volleyball and playground equipment. You can also rent canoes, kayaks and paddleboats.

A recreation passport from your vehicle registration is required for admittance to this state park.

### GROVELAND TOWNSHIP NEAR HOLLY

**Heron Beach** is situated on one of three lakes — Heron, Valley and Wildwood — in the Holly Recreation Area in Groveland Township.

This swimming beach is one of the nicest inland beaches in Michigan, according to Hour Detroit Magazine and the Detroit Free Press. There are lifeguards, a public restroom, picnic areas and playgrounds.

Heron Beach is also the newest location for WhoaZone, a floating water park, open from Memorial Day to Labor Day.

Entrance to the Holly Recreation Area is through your recreation passport. A separate admission price is charged at WhoaZone, a base price of \$15 per hour session.

Groveland Oaks County Park, on Dixie Highway at Grange Hall Road is a camping resort, park and beach, known as **Paradise Beach**, on Stewart Lake. There is a boat rental, fishing, swimming and a popular water slide.

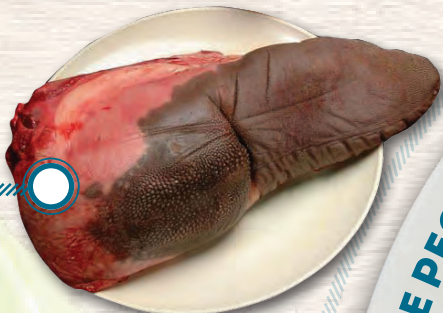
Lifeguards are on duty at the beach, which is open Memorial Day through Labor Day. If you aren't an Oakland County resident, a vehicle day pass is \$12.





#### PICKLED PIG'S FEET

Natural gelatin released by pig's trotters during cooking gives them a jellied consistency. In Creole cuisine, they were traditionally served chilled as an hors d'oeuvre or battered and fried like chicken. While trotters do not contain a lot of pure meat, their skin and cartilage are edible and once pickled are loaded with tart, porky flavor.



#### COW'S (BEEF) TONGUE

Eating tongue isn't a new phenomenon, but rather a very old one that, because of the onset of the American Factory Food Industrial Complex, we've chosen to forget. According to an essay in the April 1999 edition of Science, hominids have been chopping the tongues out of their prey for at least 2.5 million years. The tongues our pre-human ancestors were eating were probably tough and not very pleasant because they were probably eating them raw. But the tongues available to us now are tender and creamy and super beefy.

#### BLOOD SAUSAGE



There is quite a bit of nutrition in blood (especially iron and other minerals), and the addition of blood in a dish will make it seem fattier and richer than it really is. Pork blood will solidify and stay moist, while beef blood becomes crumbly and dry. And blood is cheap, so if you are on a budget think about it. Also, blood is also a spectacular binder, much like egg whites.

#### GROUND SNAILS (ESCARGOT)

Escargot, often considered a French delicacy, is served in many of the finest restaurants in the country. What some people don't know, however, is that these snails do not come from the sea — they are the nasty-looking ground snails that take over your garden. The French don't consider them a nuisance at all, but a reason to spend time with the family, walking with buckets through their yards and grassy fields in pursuit of their prize. They refer to it as "hunting."



#### FROG LEGS

Frog legs taste like chicken! At least that's what everyone says. Most of the meat on a bullfrog is the hind legs, so you need to skin and dismember your amphibians. First, make sure your frogs are actually dead. It's tough to kill a bullfrog. They don't die easy. Once they are dead, some people drive a nail through a board but this step is really unnecessary. All you need is a cutting board, and a willingness to grab a dead, slimy frog. You'll also want kitchen shears, a small, sharp knife, a set of pliers, water to wash the legs, a bowl for the legs and a trashcan for the rest of the body nearby.



#### MOUNTAIN OYSTERS

Mountain oysters, Montana tenderloin, bison balls, cowboy caviar — a testicle is still a testicle by any other name. Rocky Mountain oysters are not oysters at all. They're mammal testicles, and most commonly come from bulls, bison, pigs, and sheep. The taste is mild, maybe a little like chicken gizzards.

Some of the very first ranchers to inhabit the West needed inexpensive sources of food, so they experimented with different cuts of meat. And because they didn't waste any part of the animal, they began cooking testicles, and found them to be delicious!

#### COW BRAINS

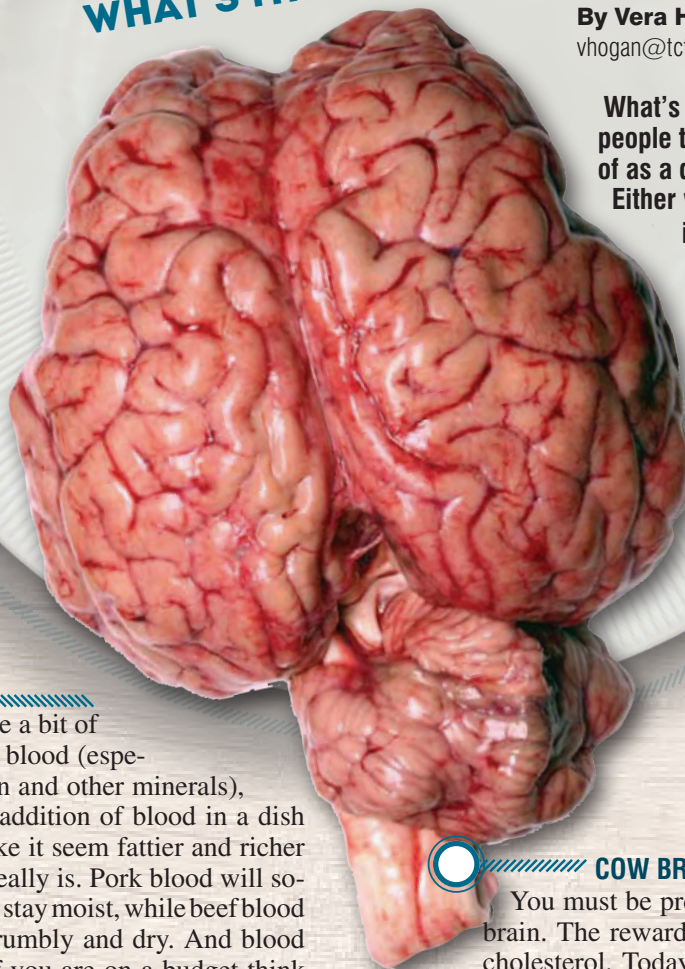
You must be pretty hungry to crack open the skull of a cow to procure its brain. The reward, however, is rich — brain is extremely fatty and high in cholesterol. Today, brain is often overlooked, which is a shame as it really is a pretty delicious part of the animal. Remember not to indulge too often, however. They are very high in calories, like 900 per serving.

# 1994 Linden grad was pre-med student, drummer and more

■ Says Linden schools gave him a firm base, sense of community that keeps him grounded

When Jarrod Montague graduated as valedictorian from Linden High School in 1994, he had no idea his life would take so many turns from pre-med student to drummer in a band that signed with Atlantic Records.

Montague, who now has five children, was the class president throughout all four years of high school. He also was National Honor Society president. He graduated with a 3.8 GPA, before weighted grades and with a “Calculus teacher that didn’t give an A.”

“The extent to which employers care about GPA depends on the type of job and extent of experience one has in the job market. The more experience you gain in the marketplace, the less likely GPA will even be discussed,” he said.

After high school, Montague attended University of Michigan-Ann Arbor as a pre-med student and then went to Michigan State University for a masters in epidemiology. He’s worked as a hospital patient attendant and U.S. Food and Drug Administration clinical trial research coordinator.

Montague also was in a band, Taproot, which was offered a record deal with Atlantic Records.

“I quit school and signed a seven-album deal with Atlantic Records. We sold one million records and toured the U.S., Europe and Japan. But when the industry changed and I had my first son on the way in 2006, I left the band and got a corporate job,” he said.

At that corporate job working for JLL, a Fortune 500 real estate firm, Montague was promoted seven times in nine years and is now a senior vice

Montague has five kids — three biological sons, ages 9, 10, and 12, and two daughters, ages 9 and 10, who he and his wife fostered and then adopted from Flint.

# Build a strong relationship with your pet's vet

Routine well visits are an important part of maintaining overall health for adults and children. The same can be said for ensuring family pets are thriving as well.

Veterinarians should be consulted for more than just illnesses. Their input is a key component of proper pet care. Having a solid relationship with the vet is in the best interests of the pet and its owner.

Open communication and familiarity with companion animals helps to avoid health issues before they appear, according to Dr. Krista Magnifico, DVM, and founder of Pawbly.com. Wellness exams facilitate discussion when the animal is not under duress and the general health of the pet can be properly assessed. According to the pet resource iHeartDogs.com, common components of well visits include the vet asking questions about exercise frequency, appetite, behavior, and any breed-specific issues. A vet will examine the pet, check gait and movement, as well as look at the eyes, ears and mouth. Routine vaccinations also are typically discussed and administered.

Veterinary Practice News advises taking a new pet to the vet a few days after he or she comes home, even if the pet's medical history has been documented extensively. This establishes a clinical file and a relationship between pet and vet and vet and pet owner.

The frequency of vet visits is often determined by the veterinarian, breed and age of the animal, and the preferences of the pet owners. The vets at The Ohio State University College of Veterinary Medicine

say that kittens or puppies may need to come in once a month for preventative shots until they reach 16 weeks of age. New pet parents also may need more guidance on training and housebreaking and can benefit from more frequent interactions with a vet early on. After pets receive all of their initial immunizations, vets typically see healthy pets annually for well visits. If the pet has a specific condition, he or she may require more frequent visits.

According to the pets division of WebMD, senior dogs, or those around age 10, should get twice-yearly checkups, as advised by most vets. Changes to hormones and major systems of the body may occur rapidly in aging pets, and more frequent visits can help discover illnesses, such as canine diabetes. Vets also can be an educated sounding board for facing an elder pet's end-of-life issues.

Veterinarians play an essential role in maintaining the health, happiness and comfort of pets. A great relationship is established early on.
