Enriching lives of the YOUNG and Old

■Elderly memory care residents interact with daycare kids for fun and much-needed interaction

Fenton — While holiday public service announcements might urge people to check on their elderly and possibly lonely neighbors, Tonia Hishke, Courtyard Manor of Fenton manager, said this interaction isn't just for the holiday season. "It's all year," she said. "Watch

out for each other. Help each other out."

Positive interaction with the elderly was the point of the event Thursday, Nov. 21. Five residents of the assisted living facility visited with Fenton Early Learning Center children for crafts, snacks and singing songs between 10 and 11:30 a.m.

Shelly Williamson is co-owner of Fenton Early Learning Center. She said this is the first time they've had elderly residents of such a facility visit their daycare, with the plan of the children interacting with seniors, "so they're not afraid of them."

She said sometimes children aren't used to octogenarians and beyond, or used to seeing an elderly person in a wheelchair.

Visiting residents were between 78 and 100 years old. The children's grandparents are likely closer to 60. "A lot of children now don't have that

The preliminary investigation revealed that northbound traffic, south of Clyde Road, was stopped due to congestion.

A 2008 Ford Edge, operated by a 75-year-old Fenton resident with five occupants in the vehicle, was traveling north on Old U.S. 23 when it struck the rear of a stopped 2003 GMC Sierra, driven by a 53-year-old

Brighton resident. The GMC Sierra was pushed forward into a 2008 Jeep Grand Cherokee, driven by a 19-year-old Fenton resident that was stopped in the roadway while waiting for traffic.

An 89-year-old woman from Fenton was a front seat passenger in the Ford Edge. She sustained serious injuries while all of the other parties involved were treated and released at the scene. She was transported to

the University of Michigan Hospital in Ann Arbor by Livingston County EMS.

Speed and alcohol do not appear to be a factor in this crash. All parties involved were wearing their seatbelts.

Deputies were assisted on scene by the Hartland Fire Department and Livingston County Ambulance. The crash remains under investigation by the Livingston County Sheriff's Office Major Crash Team.

interaction with great-grandparents or even grandparents," Hishke said. "Their grandparents may live in another state, so they don't have that interaction with actual elderly."

Many of residents have Alzheimer's or dementia. She said they only see children when they visit them at their home. The children seemed to be having fun with the Courtyard residents.

The benefits of such an event are the children becoming much more comfortable with the elderly, while enriching the lives of the Courtyard residents. "The smiles I've seen today have been amazing," Hishke said.

She has a granddaughter at the daycare, which gave her the idea to suggest to Williamson. They plan to come again for Christmas and in the future, try to make it a regular event.



Tips for safe holiday entertaining in pet-friendly households

The holidays are a time to spend with friends and family. Celebrating and entertaining are large components of what makes Thanksgiving, Christmas, Chanukah, and New Years festivities so enjoyable. Holiday hosts with pets must consider companion animals when planning the festivities.

The holiday season brings added dangers for pets. The American Veterinary Association notes that, by keeping hazards in mind, pet owners can ensure their four-legged friends enjoy the season as much as everyone else.

- Secure the tree. Securely anchor the Christmas tree so that it won't tip over on anyone, including rambunctious pets. Also, stagnant tree stand water can grow bacteria. If a pet should drink the water, it may end up with nausea or diarrhea. Replenish the tree basin with fresh water daily.
- Skip the candles. When creating mood lighting, opt for electronic or battery-powered lights instead of open flames. Pets may knock over candles, and that can be an instant fire hazard.
- · Keep food out of reach. Situate food buffets beyond the reach of hungry and curious animals. Warn guests to promptly throw out their leftovers so that dogs and cats do not sneak away with scraps that may cause stomach upset or worse. Real Simple magazine warns that fatty foods can promote pancreatitis - a potentially dangerous inflammation of the pancreas that produces toxic enzymes and causes illness and dehydration. Small bones can get lodged in a pet's throat or intestines as well.
- Avoid artificial sweeteners. Exercise caution when baking sugar-free desserts. The artificial sweetener xylitol can cause dogs' blood pressure to drop to dangerously low levels. Xylitol is found in some toothpastes and gum, so tell overnight guests to keep their toiletries secure to avoid accidental exposure.



- · Be cautious with cocktails. If the celebration will include alcoholic beverages, the ASPCA says to place unattended adult beverages where pets cannot reach them. Ingested alcohol can make pets ill, weak and even induce comas.
- Be picky about plants. Mistletoe, holly and poinsettias can be dangerous in petfriendly households. These plants can cause gastrointestinal upset and may lead to other problems if ingested. Opt for artificial replicas instead. If guests bring flowers, confirm they are nontoxic to pets before putting them on display.
- Watch the door. Guests going in and out may inadvertently leave doors open. In such instances, pets who get scared or are door dashers may be able to escape the house. Put a note by the door to watch for escaping pets.
- Designate a safe space for pets. If the holiday hustle proves too much for cats, dogs, birds, and more, give the pet a safe, quiet spot away from the crowds.

Holiday hosts should factor in pet safety when they open their homes to guests.

Barrett played at No. 4 singles and won her match against Gyselle Gutierrez 4-6, 6-0, 10-4, while Johnson played at No. 6 singles and won her match 6-2, 2-6, 6-3. Both also played in doubles matches. Barrett teamed up with Marija Leko to win her No. 2 doubles match while Johnson teamed with Sara Neves and lost at No. 3 doubles.

Johnson is in her sophomore season and posted a 9-5 record in singles matches and a 4-9 record in doubles matches this fall. During her freshman season she posted a 3-7 singles record and a 3-6 doubles record. She capped her Holly playing career by winning the No. 2 singles state title at the Division 2

meet in 2018.

Barrett began her career at Grand Valley this year and posted a 10-1 record in singles matches at a variety of flights. She was 10-4 in doubles matches, usually playing at No. 2 doubles.

"The reason I picked Wayne State was not only because I liked the programs they offered but also the team they have," Buchanan said. "I enjoyed talking to all of the teammates during my visit there. I also know that I would be an immediate contributor to their team. I really liked the fact that they had their own big goals to win regionals and go to nationals.

"I also related to this with Linden because we had always made goals, whether it was to win the Metro title, win the regional title or place well at the state meet. I really liked having these kinds of challenges, and that's exactly what I want to continue doing at Wayne State."

The Warriors placed fourth at the GLIAC Championships and placed seventh out of 31 teams at the D2 NCAA Midwest Regional this fall. Another interesting aspect about the Wayne State program is that it already has a strong tri-county flavor to the roster. Linden graduate Tanner Blaney and Fenton graduate Mitchell Chabot are on the squad as well. Buchanan will have to prepare for longer cross country races. The men's cross country teams generally compete in 8K races to start the year and conclude with 10K events. High school cross country programs run 5K races.

"I'm very excited for the longer distances because I believe that I am a very strong runner and I will perform better because I run well with the longer distances," Buchanan said. "(Being able to continue his running career at the collegiate level) means a lot to me that I get to continue doing what I love and I'm very excited for it. It also shows my dedication to the sport which means a lot to me because I can now carry on such a huge factor of my life that has impacted me so greatly."

Buchanan finished first in seven races this fall, including all three Metro League jamborees. He won the final league meet race with a time of 16:17.4. He also won a Division 2 regional championship with a time of 16:14.3, earning a spot at

the state meet. While there he placed sixth overall in the D2 race with a time of 15:57.3. He also competed in a recent MITCA Team Michigan Trials, placing second among seniors with a time of 15:43.0.

Last track season Buchanan was the Metro League's 1,600 run champion (4:30.15). He was a regional runner-up (4:20.01) in the same event and placed fifth at the D2 state meet (4:22.78).

"The Linden cross country and track programs have helped me prepare for the next level with the year-round training by holding nonmandatory practices in the winter and non-mandatory but eventually mandatory practices in the summer," Buchanan said.




the second period.
