Ground has been broken

■ The Rock Church of Fenton begins construction on \$3-million, 32,000-square-foot building

The Rock Church of Fenton (Tyrone Township) has begun construction on its new building at 11499 Linden Rd.

The congregation has been saving money over the past few years and reached its goal to cover the \$3 million cost of the new building.

Neil Thompson, director of ministry operations, said after a couple of set-

backs with permitting in the past few months, all permits have now been approved. The Tyrone Township board approved the church's plans at its last board meeting via Zoom.

Thompson said reaching their goal and getting permits approved has been an inspiring moment for the body of believers at The Rock.

"Over the past nine weeks, the church has not been meeting in person," Thompson said. "Instead, we have been meeting on the weekends digitally on Facebook, YouTube, and a weekly

outreach special on Fox66.

"While this has been a challenge, it's exciting to see what God and the church can do, even during a pandemic."

Church leaders anticipate this new building to be an outreach to the com-

munity, a beacon of light. Thompson added that it will be a place where anyone can feel comfortable to attend no matter what they believe or are seeking.

the time and effort put forth by both sides of the bargaining table to reach this positive outcome.”

The two-year contract includes a full step and a 1-percent increase across the salary grid for the 2019-2020 school year with no additional compensation for 2020-2021.

The contract also includes items such as a higher sick day cap and increased payment in lieu of taking their medical benefits. If a teacher does not take the

benefit package, they receive money that is placed in a 403 B retirement account.

The FEA and the Fenton Area Public Schools (FAPS) administration will be collaborating on the 2020-2021 school calendar and will publish the calendar by Aug. 1.

Adam Hartley, superintendent of FAPS, said, “I am appreciative of the FEA and the Board of Education for working together to come to an agreement so we may focus on preparing for next school year during this unprecedented time in education.

“Our teachers have continued to work hard over the COVID-19 shutdown and to be able to agree on this contract before the summer is a true testament of our ability to work together.”

FEA President Pam Hayes added, “I am very pleased that we have come to terms on a contract. Although it’s taken a long time and has been difficult for both sides, I am relieved that in the end, we were able to work together to do what’s best for everyone involved.”

The FEA’s last contract expired June 30, 2019. Union negotiators began meeting with district officials in March of 2019.

Just sayin'...

Dirt, raw eggs and swimming hole water — we swallowed it all

When our boys were growing up, my husband used to say, “If Mom sneezes, we’re all gonna die!” The reason was that I very rarely got sick. Everyone at his work, my office and the kids’ school could be sick with colds and flu, but I usually never got what they had. He thought for sure that I was a carrier.

Now that I’m getting older, I do get sick from time to time, but not “real” sick, and I have a couple other minor ailments.

I often wonder if my immune system is stronger because of the way I grew up.

When I was a kid, it was nothing to get very dirty while playing outside and even swallow some of that dirt, accidentally of course. During the summer, we swam in an old limestone quarry that was turned into a swimming hole. The water we swam in was ripe with vegetation, fish, turtles, snakes and other critters. I know I swallowed a lot of that water, and a few bugs.

We rarely ate processed food, except maybe breakfast cereal. My dad had a vegetable garden and most of our side dishes were fresh. We ate a lot of chicken and not too much red meat. My mother used to wrap leftover food in wax paper. She never threw that wax paper away but

instead reused it again and again until it fell apart.

One of my favorite things to do was lick the beaters and bowl after my mom put a cake or cookies, with raw eggs in the batter, in the oven. Another thing my mother made that was a Christmas Eve treat and still one of my favorites was steak tartare. That’s ground up raw meat mixed with onion, salt and pepper, and raw eggs.

Until about 25 years ago, I never heard of E.coli or salmonella.

Because I loved playing outside and rolling around in the grass, I sometimes got chigger bites. Chigger larvae attach to a person and the itching is terrible. My parents didn’t give me anti-itch cream or antihistamine pills. They covered each bite with clear nail polish. When it dried, the little suckers just died, and their tiny corpses peeled away with the polish a day or so later.

Don’t get me wrong, with today’s pandemic I am very cautious. And whenever I go out, which isn’t often, I always practice social distancing and wear a mask to protect other people — from me — in case my husband was right.

Just sayin’!

In a press statement, Thompson said, “The building’s design will be utilitarian in nature; it will not have stained glass or fancy decorations. It will be plain in nature; the building is simply a tool to show people that God loves

them no matter what they have done and that they can find peace in Him. By building it in this way, it allows us to continue to be debt-free, allowing us to continue to serve the community in whatever way we can.”



"Pale Horse, Pale Rider"


by Katherine Anne Porter
