Becoming one with the water

■ Stand up paddle boards, kayaks can be relaxing, invigorating simultaneously

Anyone who has ever cruised across one of the many local lakes or down the Shiawassee River on a stand up paddle board knows what a good core workout it is. You're watching for boaters' wake, ordinary waves all while balancing on a board that is just over 2 feet wide and about 10 feet long.

A stand up paddle board is referred to as a SUP.

Many stand up paddle board enthusiasts will wait until the lake surface is as smooth as glass to go out. The calm serenity, fresh air, smell of lake water and sunshine is relaxing, yet invigorating.

No fuel is needed because your movement is completely reliant on your actions. If you get tired, you simply kneel down on the board, sit, or even lay down on it.

According to Pumped Up SUP, a blog by SUP experts at pumpedupsup.com, in addition to blending in with nature, there are multiple benefits of SUP.

BENEFITS OF STAND UP PADDLEBOARDING

- **Increases core strength** — SUP engages your core muscles and builds abdominal strength and lean muscle tone, while at the same time strengthening arms, legs, back, and shoulders.

- **Builds stamina** — SUP is an activity that is so enjoyable that you can end up working out for hours before you realize you have been exerting yourself at all. Best of all, it is a low impact workout that provides a great alternative to injury-prone runners.

- **Enhances joint stability** — Balancing on a SUP board activates the small muscles in the foot and lower leg in a way that mimics physical therapy

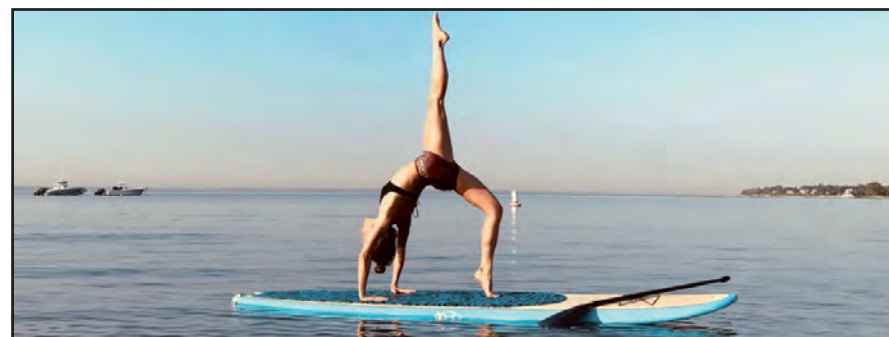

exercises used to treat plantar fasciitis and other ailments. The dynamics of standing on a board with an element of instability from the water utilizes muscles critical for balance and joint support in a way that no other recreational activity does.

- **Reduces stress** — The powerful combination of being out on the water, enjoying nature, socializing with other paddlers, and enjoying the indescribable sensation of standing on water is an amazing stress reducer. SUP paddlers almost unanimously report a feeling of well-being after going for a paddle, similar to “runners high,” but without the need for intense exertion.

- **Vitamin D** — SUP gets you outside in the sun, allowing your body to produce the vitamin D that so many people are deficient in from too much time indoors. Vitamin D is crucial for calcium production and strong bones, as well as peak mental functioning.

YOGA ON A STAND UP PADDLE BOARD

Many have found that taking yoga routines to the water on a SUP makes for an enhanced experience. Some of the benefits of SUP yoga include:

- You get a different kind of workout: Doing yoga on a SUP engages muscles that you may neglect during your on-land practice.
- To develop mindfulness: The added

challenge of doing yoga on a wobbly board will force you to be very present and intentional with all your movements.

- To encourage a beginner's mindset: If you've been practicing yoga for some time now, you might be on autopilot as you do downward facing dog for the thousandth time. But, even the most experienced yogis can learn something new from simple poses, and approaching your yoga practice with the engaged and curious mind of a beginner is a good way to do so. SUP yoga is a great way to work on maintaining a beginner's mindset because it introduces new challenges to your yoga routine.

KAYAKING

Similar to using a SUP, kayaking is quiet, peaceful, energizing and it lets you blend in with nature's finest attributes on the water.

Whether you are out by yourself or with a friend or even a large flotilla of kayaking enthusiasts, cruising around the lakes while not disturbing anything makes for a peaceful afternoon. Some groups even light up the kayaks with waterproof LED lights and extend their trips into the evening hours.

There are numerous designs of SUPs and kayaks, along with paddles, on the market. Some boards are perfect for beginners and some are designed for racing. There also are numerous YouTube videos to show you how to stand up on your SUP once you are in the water.

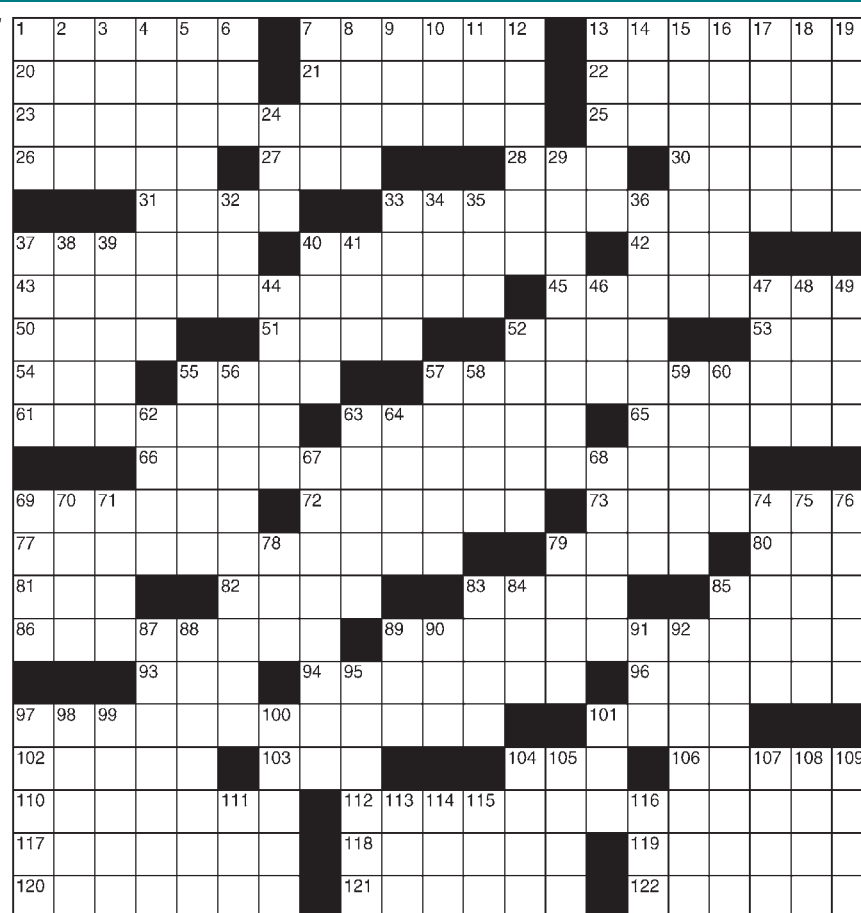
