"Burn Our Bodies Down" by Rory Power

But she wants to know, and she goes to her mother's hometown to find answers. Power is the New York Times bestselling author of "Wilder Girls."

In this funny but raw story about two women in opposite stages of life, an 18-year-old pregnant pizza delivery girl struggling in See BOOK on 28



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



In 1824 - Andrew Jackson won the presidential popular vote but lost by one vote in the House of Representatives to John Quincy Adams after an


Electoral College dead-lock.

In 2000 - The Presidential election was decided by an extremely narrow margin. George W. Bush won the state of Florida by just 537 votes, making him the next President of the United States. Close



to 6 million voters went to the polls in Florida. It might not have been by one vote, but certainly every vote counted.




