Check your smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors

Check the batteries, keep generators outside, check furnace

As the weather gets colder, local fire chiefs are reminding people to check the batteries in their carbon monoxide (CO) detectors and smoke detectors.

It could save your life and the lives of your family.

"I will give you six good reasons to check your carbon monoxide detectors - in memory of the Quasarano Family," said Fenton Township Fire Chief Ryan Volz. "You would be surprised of the alarms we run for both carbon monoxide and smoke detectors that could be avoided with simple housekeeping."

The area community mourned the loss of the Ouasarano family of six who were found dead in the Fenton Township home from carbon monoxide poisoning in February 2016. After the tragedy, the Fenton Township Fire Department launched campaigns to install new detectors in area homes and for residents to do the same.

The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) reports hundreds

of deaths from carbon monoxide a vear.

Volz said residents should, once a month, use a vacuum to go over the surface of the detector to keep it free of dust of dust. Change the batteries every six months.

"Some of the new detectors are sealed so you don't have to change the battery," he said. "But most of all check

the date on the detector and after 10 years replace it. These devices will save your life if properly maintained."

> Linden Fire Chief Brian Will said it's especially important to check your smoke alarms and carbon monoxide detectors during late fall when people start to use their furnaces and fireplaces.

> "It is recommended that a carbon monoxide detector should be placed on each

level of the home just outside the sleeping areas. Replace the batteries once a year. Daylight Saving Time is a good time to remember to do this," Will said.

He recommends testing all of the detectors often throughout the year, every month is possible.

"WegetCO alarm calls throughout the year, but again, late fall is when we get the most calls when residents start up their heating device, furnaces, fireplaces or temporary space heaters," he said.

Will also added, "Please stress, under no circumstances, do not operate a generator inside a garage or basement of a home."

Fenton Fire Chief Bob Cairnduff said it is "extremely important to make sure smoke detectors are working and that the batteries are checked twice a year and replaced annually."

He recommends using 10-year lithium batteries.

"The fires in today's homes burn hotter and faster than ever. This is due to the type of plastic materials used to make almost everything in the home. Typically, you have less than two minutes to make it out of a home after a fire starts," he said. See CHECK on 22




