INGREDIENTS

2 tablespoons brown sugar
1 tablespoon chili powder
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon ground black pepper
1 teaspoon garlic powder
1 teaspoon onion powder
1 pound pork rib tips
1 (18 ounce) bottle of BBQ sauce, divided
1 tablespoon liquid smoke flavoring

DIRECTIONS

Mix brown sugar, chili powder, salt, pepper, garlic powder, and onion powder in a small bowl. Rub each rib with dry rub mixture until thoroughly coated. Let rest for 10 minutes.

Mix BBQ sauce and liquid smoke until well combined.

Place ribs in the slow cooker and pour BBQ sauce mixture evenly over ribs.

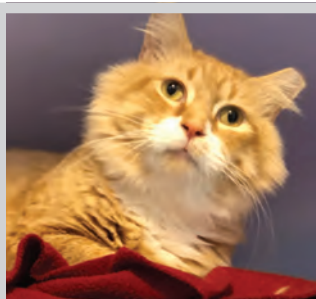

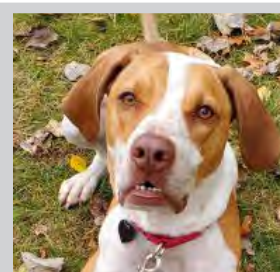

4. Conducted a public hearing on, and first reading of, a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment to rezone parcel 06-11-527-029, (va cant land on Bowles Street), from R-5 to PUD, with additional conditions, to be added to the Gables of North Shore condominium for the purpose of constructing accessory buildings.
5. Conducted a public hearing on, and first reading of, a proposed Zoning Ordinance amendment to rezone part of parcel 06-291-200-007, (vacant land adjacent to Price's Airport on Silver Lake Road), to create a new PUD project for the development of a senior assisted living facility.
6. Approved a motion to continue the optional 80/20 rules for 2021 to comply with the Publicly Funded Health Insurance Contribution Act, Public Act 152 of 2011.
7. Re-appointed Melissa Farney and Pete Matta to the Fenton Township Zoning Board of Appeals for the term ending November 30, 2023.
8. Adjourned at 8:48 p.m.

Cook on low until ribs are tender, 4 to 6 hours.

Set an oven rack about 6 inches from the heat source and preheat the oven's broiler.

Remove ribs from the slow cooker and baste with remaining BBQ sauce.

Broil ribs in the preheated oven for 3 to 5 minutes on each side.



FORGOTTEN JAMBALAYA

Serves 11 (Tasteofhome.com)

INGREDIENTS

- 1 can (14-1/2 ounces) diced tomatoes, undrained
- 1 can (14-1/2 ounces) beef or chicken broth
- 1 can (6 ounces) tomato paste
- 3 celery ribs, chopped
- 2 medium green peppers, chopped
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 5 garlic cloves, minced
- 3 teaspoons dried parsley flakes
- 2 teaspoons dried basil
- 1-1/2 teaspoons dried oregano
- 1-1/4 teaspoons salt
- 1/2 teaspoon cayenne pepper
- 1/2 teaspoon hot pepper sauce
- 1 pound boneless skinless chicken breasts, cut into 1-inch cubes
- 1 pound smoked sausage, halved and cut into 1/4-inch slices
- 1/2 pound uncooked medium shrimp, peeled and deveined

DIRECTIONS

In a 5-qt. slow cooker, combine the tomatoes, broth and tomato paste. Stir in the celery, green peppers, onion, garlic, seasonings and pepper sauce. Stir in chicken and sausage.

Cover and cook on low for 4-6 hours or until chicken is no longer pink. Stir in shrimp. Cover and cook 15-30 minutes longer or until shrimp turn pink. Serve with rice.

Freeze option: Place individual portions of cooled stew in freezer containers and freeze. To use, partially thaw in refrigerator overnight. Heat through in a saucepan, stirring occasionally and adding a little water if necessary.



VEGAN: SLOW COOKER SWEET POTATO QUINOA STEW

Serves 8 (Sweetpeasandsaffron.com)

INGREDIENTS

- 4 cups sweet potatoes, cubed
- 11 ounce can of corn
- 19 ounce can black beans drained and rinsed
- 19 ounce can diced tomatoes including juices
- 1 cup red onion, diced
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 2 tablespoons cumin
- 1 tablespoon chili powder
- 4-5 cups stock
- 2/3 cup uncooked quinoa
- After cooking
- 2 tablespoons lime juice
- Additional salt, maybe 1/4 teaspoon

DIRECTIONS

Place all ingredients in the base of a 5 quart slow cooker.

Cook on low for 6 hours. Add the lime juice and additional salt if necessary. Serve with bread, cheese or yogurt.
