



Happy 100th birthday

■Longtime Holly resident Anna Dean celebrates milestone with family and friends

Longtime Holly resident Anna Dean celebrated her 100th birthday Saturday, Feb. 13. She has been living at Brookdale senior living in Holly for two years and celebrated her 98th and 99th birthdays there with family and friends.

Anna was born Anna G. Greavu in 1921 in Indiana Harbor, Indiana. She was the youngest of five children to Cornel and Mary Greavu. She had two older sisters, Mary and Helen and a younger sister, Virginia. The eldest sibling was her brother Cornel.
