Corned beef hash

Makes four servings

This corned beef hash is a two-step process. Start by cooking the beef the day before (if you also want to have it for dinner that night, just double the recipe). The next day, shred the cooked corned beef and throw the hash together.

INGREDIENTS:

CORNED BEEF

2 pounds uncooked corned beef brisket (about 1 small), rinsed, trimmed if fatty, spice packet discarded if included

4 sprigs flat-leaf parsley

3 bay leaves, torn

1 tablespoon black peppercorns

1 tablespoon coriander seeds

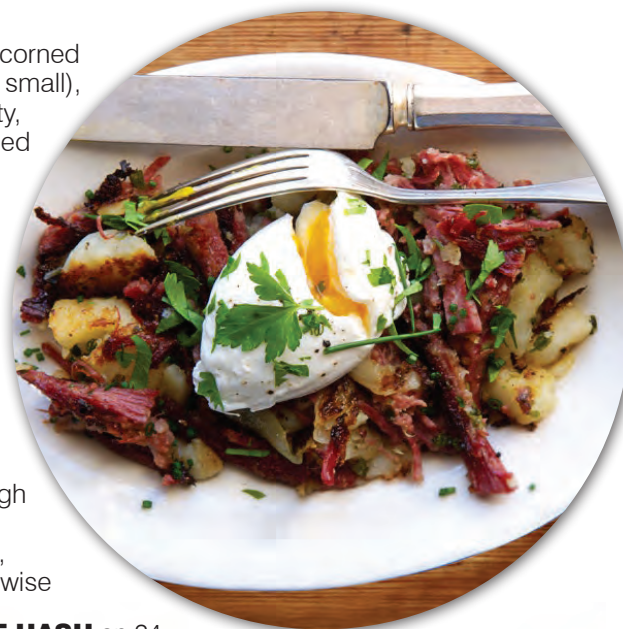
1 tablespoon yellow mustard seeds

1 medium onion, peeled, halved through root

1 large russet potato, peeled, halved crosswise

Sept. 18, the half-way point between holidays.

The first parade held in St. Patrick's honor took place in America, not Ireland, in 1601 in what is now St. Augustine, Florida. And the first actual St. Patrick's Day parade also took place in America, in 1737, although it was pretty much just a stroll down the middle of a street in Boston by a few Irish Protestants to honor the patron saint of their motherland.

The first St. Patrick's Day parade in New York City was held in 1762, 14 years before the signing of the Declaration of Independence and was organized by Irish troops serving in British colonies.

The Catholic Church first recog-

nized March 17 as a feast day commemorating Ireland's best-known and most beloved patron saint, Saint Patrick, in 1631. With rare exception, March 17 always fell during the Christian holy season of Lent, when alcohol consumption was prohibited by the Church. But on Saint Patrick's feast day, the ban on alcohol was lifted, presumably because it was a feast day, and feasting usually included alcohol, according to nationaltoday.com.

Drinking alcohol appears to be a modern American phenomenon not firmly rooted in Irish tradition. When they first came to America, the Irish were rejected and despised. Now everyone wants to be Irish on St. Patrick's Day.

CORNEB BEEF HASH

HASH

¼ cup chopped fresh flat-leaf parsley, plus more for serving
Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper
4 tablespoons unsalted butter
1 teaspoon distilled white vinegar
4 large eggs
Chopped fresh chives (for serving)

PREPARATION:

CORNEB BEEF

STEP 1 - Place corneb beef in a large Dutch oven or other heavy pot and add water to cover by 1 inch. Add parsley sprigs, bay leaves, peppercorns, coriander seeds, and mustard seeds. Bring to a boil; reduce heat, cover, and simmer, skimming surface often and adding more water to pot as needed to keep meat submerged, until corneb beef is tender, 3½–4 hours.

STEP 2 - Add onion and potato to corneb beef in pot and cook until vegetables are very tender, 20–25 minutes. Remove onion and potato from pot. Let cool; wrap separately and chill. Let corneb beef cool in cooking liquid. Transfer corneb beef to an airtight container and add as much cooking liquid as will fit (at least 1 cup). Cover and chill. Discard any remaining aromatics and cooking liquid.

STEP 3 - DO AHEAD: Corneb beef and vegetables can be cooked 2 days ahead; keep chilled until ready to use.

HASH

STEP 4 - Remove corneb beef from cooking liquid and shred

enough to measure 2 cups (reserve any remaining corneb beef for sandwiches or snacking).

STEP 5 - Preheat oven to 200 degrees. Thinly slice cooked onion and cut cooked potato into ½" pieces; toss in a large bowl with corneb beef and ¼ cup parsley. Moisten with cooking liquid if mixture is dry; season with salt and pepper.

STEP 6 - Heat 2 Tbsp. butter in a medium nonstick skillet over medium heat. Add ½ of corneb beef mixture and press into a pancake. Cook undisturbed until underside is brown and crisp, 6–8 minutes. Set a plate over pan and carefully invert pancake onto plate; slide back into pan, pressing back into shape if needed. Cook until second side is brown and crisp, 6–8 minutes. Transfer hash to a rimmed baking sheet (it may break up a little), tent with foil, and keep warm in oven until ready to serve. Repeat with remaining butter and corneb beef mixture.

STEP 7 - Meanwhile, bring 2 inches water to a boil in a large saucepan; reduce heat to a gentle simmer and add vinegar. Crack an egg into a small bowl and gently slide egg into water. Repeat with remaining eggs, waiting until whites are opaque before adding the next (about 30 seconds apart). Poach until whites are set and yolks are still runny, about 3 minutes. Using a slotted spoon, transfer eggs as they are done to paper towels.

STEP 8 - Serve eggs over hash, seasoned with salt and pepper and topped with chives and more parsley.

STEP 9 - DO AHEAD: Eggs can be poached 2 hours ahead; place in a bowl of ice water and chill. Reheat in barely simmering water 1 minute just before serving.



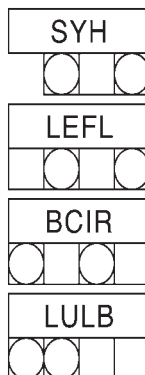
