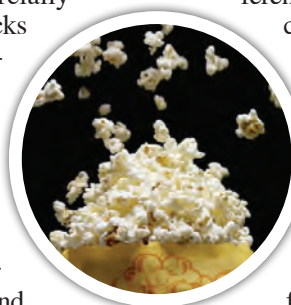
BALANCE PREPACKAGED AND HOMEMADE


