Note from the President and CEO Joyce Donaldson

ince the initial meeting on May 25th, 1950, where 60 members of the Lake Orion Chamber of Commerce met at the Methodist Church to elect its first Board of Directors, the Chamber has worked diligently on creating a robust business-friendly environment in which businesses can thrive and prosper. The Articles of Incorporation were officially executed several weeks later on June 19th, 1950.

From the onset, the Lake Orion Chamber of Commerce went to work to find ways to support Lake Orion in a variety of initiatives. To help with putting Lake Orion on the map and encouraging visitors to visit, the Chamber held a contest to create a tagline for Lake Orion. The contest was won by James Tate and the tagline "Lake Orion Where Living is a Vacation" was introduced.

A month after the formation of the Chamber, they were encouraging people to shop local by having a gigantic

sale featuring many local vendors, reporting in the Orion Weekly Review, that the cooperation and collaboration of local merchants made the shop local sale one of the greatest bargain events in the history of the community.

The Chamber worked closely with the village on projects for paving the roads in the village proper and addressing concerns regarding village parking. The Chamber created and advertised a "Citizenship Checklist" encouraging residents to be active in local politics and to vote.

On November 9. 1998 the Articles of

Incorporation to officially change from the Lake Orion Chamber of Commerce to the Orion Area Chamber of Commerce were submitted and approved.

Today, the Orion Area Chamber

of Commerce is the center of Orion business as the largest nonprofit organization in Orion Township fostering, promoting, and uniting small businesses.

We pride ourselves on promoting business and cultivating opportuni-

ties for members through networking events and educational programs – uniting leaders and influencers. The Chamber provides resources, connections, and advocacy while vigorously promoting our business

Networking Groups (CNG), After Hours Networking Mixer, Strategic Planning Educational Workshop, Board Meeting, Ambassador Committee Meeting, Golf Committee Meeting, Legacy Committee Meeting, and four Ribbon Cutting Celebrations.



How the Lake Orion Chamber of Commerce began

he Orion Area Chamber of Commerce is set to celebrate its 75th anniversary, and from its humble beginnings has grown into a stalwart champion of the entire Orion business community with more than 330 members.

But the origins of the chamber began in 1950 when merchants in the Village of Lake Orion began discussing ways to promote their businesses, attract people to the village and create a mechanism for downtown improvements.

Lake Orion business people met at 6:30 p.m. May 18, 1950 at the Methodist Church House in Lake Orion for the purpose of forming a chamber of commerce.

President Russell Basset and Secretary Morton T. Scott, both of the Pontiac Chamber of Commerce, were on hand to advise the Lake Orion business merchants on the regular procedures of a chamber of commerce.

"It is hoped to set up a temporary organization at this meeting which will function until a permanent group

can be brought into being," the Orion Weekly Review reported at the time. "Problems pertaining to form, size and activities will be discussed."

It was a big undertaking at the time, and more than 60 Lake Orion merchants attending the meeting to discuss forming a chamber of commerce in the village. Tickets for the meeting and dinner were \$1.50 - to cover the cost of the meal.

Forty-two people pledged mem-

bership that evening and agreed on an initiation fee of \$25. At the time, the thought was for the chamber to focus specifically on the downtown area, not the entire township.

Scott explained groundwork for starting the chamber and the Lake Orion members discussed procedures, meeting dates and agreed upon a program for choosing a slate of directors.

"Interest in the new organization is in evidence throughout the Village in almost every discussion when a few citizens gather," the Review reported.

A week later on May 25, the group chose its directors, with 23 names placed in nomination for the 13 seats. The 13 chosen would then appoint the chamber's slate of officers and determine the policy of the organization for one year.

"This step marks a forward move on the part of the Lake Orion merchants to create better shopping conditions in the community and to organize the citizens into a harmonious group for the betterment of all," the Review reported.

The merchants elected 13 Board of Directors members to serve until Jan. 1, 1951: W.E. Burde, James Haddrill, William Porritt, Earl Milliman, Max Wichmann, Oren Thomas, Earl Cascaddan, Ray Van Wagoner, Sterling Schaar, Harry Slater, William O'Brien, Al Walker and Marcus Freud.

Immediately following the election of the directors, the meeting was closed and the board met privately to elect officers. Earl Milliman, who owned a car dealership on the corner of Broadway and Shadbolt streets at what is now The Irish Tavern, was elected the first president.

Rodney Wiley was elected vice president; Walter Shoup, treasurer, and Harry Slater was voted in as the temporary secretary for the new officers slate.

Thus was the Lake Orion Chamber of Commerce officially brought into existence, now with more than 60 members.

While chambers of commerce today have committees within their organizations, the committees of the chamber in the 1950s had a slightly different focus. Committees formed in the Lake Orion Chamber included agriculture, civic affairs, fire prevention, health, housing, legislation, recreation, safety, industries and trade promotion.

The chamber quickly set about coming up with ideas for improvements for the village, including putting garbage cans on the four corners in downtown to discourage littering.

The chamber then made plans in June 1950 to encourage local shopping and bring visitors to the village for the Fourth of July holiday – one of the first promotional activities of the newly-created organization. They advertised the chamber's first three day sale on June 30, July 1 and July 3 with "everyday items at cost in a gigantic pre-holiday sale arranged by the Chamber of Commerce."

"The cooperation of the local merchants has combined to make this one of the greatest bargain events in the history of the community," the Orion Weekly Review reported.

In August 1950, the Lake Orion

Chamber became affiliated with the United States Chamber of Commerce. Chamber members were alerted to the possibility of sending a representative to Chicago for a national meeting on the "Korean crisis." Milliman suggested a Citizen Checklist that would be sponsored by the Lake Orion Chamber.

The chamber also discussed plans for advertising the Village of Lake Orion through the use of pamphlets or small books listing places of business, tourist facilities and vacation activities to attract people to the village.

Today the chamber has more than 330 members, a fulltime president and CEO, an operations manager, a 10-member board of directors, ambassadors; held a total of 100 events, programs, ribbon cuttings and meetings in 2024; and is a voice for the local business community

"Where Living is a Vacation"

veryone in and around the Orion Area is familiar with the popular and catchy tagline "Where Living is a Vacation." What's lesser known — and sometimes debated — is the origin of the beloved slogan.

"Our community is proud of our roots as a vacation destination and the beautiful surroundings including the lakes and parks that still make up our landscape, so it's no surprise that for generations 'Where Living is a Vacation' has been the perfect way to describe our area," Orion Area Chamber of Commerce President and CEO Joyce Donaldson said. "What few people know is that the Chamber of Commerce is to thank for the start of that tagline."

The Friday, June 23, 1950 edition of the Orion Weekly Review (now the Lake Orion Review)


confirms Donaldson's claim. Right on the front page is an article

titled "Board of Commerce Offers Prize for Name." The article details a Chamber of

Commerce contest seeking a slogan for the community. From the article, "Would you like to win a \$25 table model radio? Nothing to it. Just pick out a good slogan which you think best describes Lake orion as a "Mecca for Tourists and Vacationers" in the heart of the Michigan Auto Industry. A coupon will appear in next week's issue of this newspaper. Clip it out, fill in, and mail to the Board of Commence, Lake Orion, you may be the lucky one."

As promised, the following week's edition of the Orion Weekly Review included the coupon on a two-page spread featuring

> Lake Orion Board of Commerce Pre-Holiday Specials from its members. On the left hand page was a coupon with a large headline Win A Prize! Details read: "Pick a name or slogan you think descries Lake Orion best as a vacation land in the center of the auto industry or use any idea you think will draw attention to the advantage of the community. The Board of Commerce will use the slogan in future advertising of the community as the "Heart of the Lakes Region" a "Vacationers Paradise" a "Tourists Mecca" the "Center of




the Automobile Industry" and "A Pleasant Place to Live and Shop" the year around. A \$25 table model radio will be awarded for the slogan, which is the opinion of the judges "Best describes Lake Orion."

Fill in the coupon below and mail to the "Board of Commerce" Lake Orion, Michigan.

The coupon noted that the contest closes July 15, 1950.

"After reviewing what I'm sure were hundreds of entries, the board made their selection," said Donaldson.

And in the Friday, August 4, 1950 edition of the Orion Weekly Review a front page article reports the results of the contest. From the article. "About 50 members of the Lake Orion Chamber of Commerce met at the Methodist Church House on last Thursday night for a discussion of the activities of the group since its inception late in May of this year ... During the meeting, the winner of the prize for the name which describes Lake Orion best was introduced and presented with the radio. The slogan Continued on page 30





'Mr. Chamber' dies

Charles Williams, a man who helped change Orion Township, died suddenly of a heart attack on Feb. 12, 1993. He was 71.

Karen Loerch, a former president of Orion Area Chamber of Commerce, described Williams as 'Mr. Chamber of Commerce.' He was president of the organization from 1974-1986.

"He did a lot for this area. It was one of his major interests. He worked hard to keep this a hometown community," Loerch said. As owner of Ladd/Williams Associates, Inc,

Williams was a major developer of Hi Hill, the first big subdivision in the rownship, in the 1960s. According to Loerch, he was a main instigator

in getting General Motors to build a plant in Orion. Jim Gaylord said Williams was in a "class by himself." The two were co-owners of Gaylord Williams, a real estate firm, from 1980-88.

"His work was perfect. Every detail was on file. And he did a lot for industry," Gaylord added.

Gaylord said Williams was very active on the Board of Realtors arbitration committee. "It was a tough thing to do. It's kind of like being a judge. But after dealing with Charlie, people didn't go away mad," he added.

Williams had been on Oxford Bank's Board of Directors since 1977

"He was a professional, a community leader, a realtor and a developer," Oxford Bank president Randy Fox said.

"He did much to shape the Orion that we are so proud of today. As a bank director, we relied on his counsel. And as a friend, I found him to be sensitive and supportive."

Williams was also a member of the 88th Infantry Division (Blue Devils) Past President National and Michigan Chapter, current National Secretary, Past President of North Oakland County Board of Realtors, Lake Orion Rotary and Manager of the Bloomfield Village.

He was a highly respected businessman and appraiser and served on many other crvice organizations in the area.

He is survived by his wife Mary.

He is also survived by his children. Kathleen (Ted) Price, Christine Williams, Deborah (Dwayne) Clayton, Patricia (Warren) Oberlee, Michael (Alayne) Williams and Laurie (Michael) German; a sister, Helen (Robert) Brewer; and he was a loving "Poppa Charlie" to seven grandchildren

Funeral services were Feb. 16 from the Lake Orion Chapel, Sparks Griffin Funeral Home. Rev. Clark Cowden officiated.
